- (a) Compare the process of polymerisation of ethylene and glucose. Include relevant chemical equations in your answer. 3

Ethylene - the initialisation where the breaking of the ~~free~~ double bond, providing it with free radical sites on either ends ($\cdot\text{C}-\text{C}\cdot$), then addition where other hydrocarbon chains with radical sites, are joined up and then the end termination, where it terminates the radical ends. Glucose is polymerised similar but due to its, bulky structure they join by having H_2O as a by product.
