

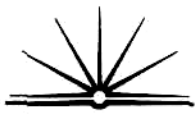


Q16. Groups in context.

The second group is people with disabilities/special needs. Their security & safety is met by housing through

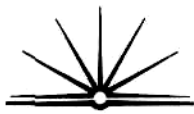


getting ramps, special handles, or special railings in and outside the house installed to help them feel secure & safe,
