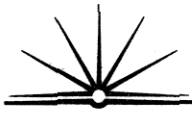
(ii) The first technique that was used to convey the idea in the song was the repetition of 5 particular lines "Don't it always seem to go That you don't know what you've got Till it's gone They

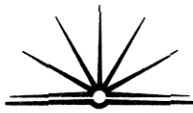
do that to all the animals that were there first we tore down their home and didn't think what we were doing.
