(A)(i) The change mentioned in the song lyric is "They paved paradise and put ~~a~~ up a parking."

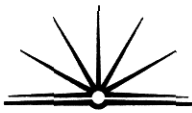
(ii) The two techniques which are used to convey ideas in the song are first person narrative, ^{scarcasm} ~~scarsam~~ is used. example

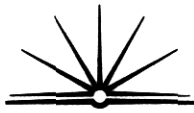
