Toni Mitchell has changed attitudes and realised ~~that~~ what she is missing out on now she is gone. "That you don't know what you've got till it's gone."

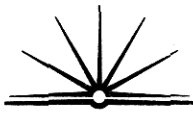

There in the article they talk about the use of digital cameras, laptops, email, modems etc - these have helped them to "strengthen their community and build economic independence."

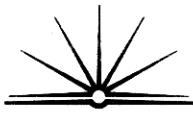
