- (a) Using Sources A and B, calculate the percentage of Brazil's population living in Sao Paulo in the year 2000. 1

$$165405000 \div 17800,000 = 9.29241573$$

$$9.29241573 \div 100 = 0.0929241573 \quad \text{answer} = 9.3\%$$

- (b) Using Source A, identify TWO features of the population pyramid that make it typical of a mega city in the developing world. 2

The greatest % of population is between 0-4 years of age, this indicates increasing birth rates typical of developing mega cities. The steep incline of the pyramid suggests a rapid change of rate in the average age of citizens, from older to younger, a trend which suggests population growth.

- (c) Describe ONE health issue and ONE social issue that a mega city in the developing world could face in the next decade. 4

Health issue Outbreak of disease. Mega-cities of

the developing world have a staff lack of sufficient health service and running water. The presence of poor living conditions and a physically insufficiently cared population raises chances of the outbreaks of disease.
