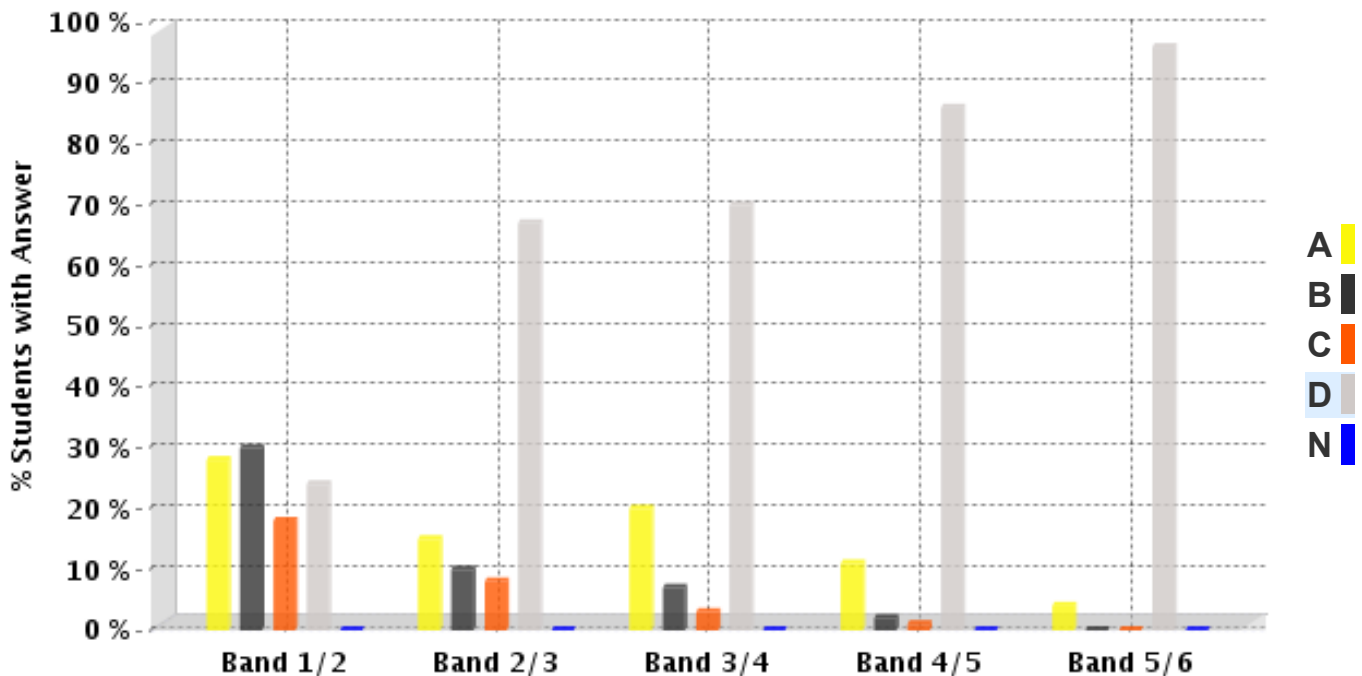


Question 11
