Albert Speer joined the Nazi Party in 1931 as an architect. His experience and passion for ~~his~~ architecture and design made Speer have a close connection to Hitler. Speer's first job was given to him in 1933. He was to build the new Nazi headquarters in Berlin. Speer's effective speed and creativity on this job pleased Hitler greatly as Speer's performance at such a task exceeded his expectations. As Speer pleased Hitler so greatly he was given the position of "Artistic & Technical production of Nazi rallies & demonstrations" that same year.

Albert Speer's ability to influence Hitler was of great advantage to Speer's career. In 1934 Speer was in charge in building a position for which the Nuremberg rallies could occur (the remembrance of the Munich Putsch).

In 1937 Hitler gave Speer the position of "Inspector of the construction of the Reich

Capital. This position greatly improved Speers status in the party, now allowed to interact with Nazi leaders.

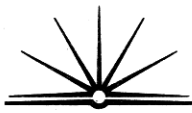
A year later 1938 saw Speers and Hitlers relationship to be much tighter. Hitler asked Speer to build his new Chancellory

Speer uprising in the Nazi Party allowed his career to exceed his expectations.

From years of Architecture and design, He was appointed as "Minister of Munitions" in the war efforts. Hitler had trust in Speer, that he was given full power in every decision to do with munitions

In 1943 the position of "Reich Minister for War Armaments and Production". This entitled Speer to have authority over the home front war efforts.

The significant events in Speers life had varied from Architecture and design from 1931-42; then to relations in German war efforts from 1942 to the downfall of the Nazi Party in 1945.
