There are many groups in society that are deeply disadvantaged, leading to them being deprived of maintaining a high status in society.

In order to have access to socially valued resources one must have access and be familiar with technology, and must must have a prestige label of class socio economic status.

The Homeless have none of such luxuries. Not even a place to sleep. Homeless are greatly disadvantaged and they are judged on their performance before they actually perform.

Being discriminated upon is totally normal and being desperate for help and assistance has become like so hard and so they have resorted to giving up.

The Homeless people do not have access to technology. It being the number one absolutely necessary talent to have only because they cannot afford it.
