society has had ~~a~~ a major effect
on the ~~role~~ lives and ~~lively~~ hood
of the Australian Under class, and
in many cases these people have
been restricted from getting access
to ~~asocially~~ valued resources, though

helped.

The Underclass in Australia consists
of the unemployed and the working
poor. the people who rely on a
social security payment to get by.
It is this class of people who
have to suffer the most ~~bad~~
trouble in accessing socially valued
resources, either as a result of
location and restriction of ~~services~~,
~~services~~ and technology or through
~~conscious~~ or un conscious



discrimination or as a result of money or socioeconomic status.

Location and restrictions to technology as a result of a rural location imposes difficulties upon a person in the underclass or a poor socioeconomic status. In many ways technology can be a restriction to people in the access to socially valued resources like health care, ~~welfare~~ welfare, and counseling. Many social resources have internet ~~sign~~ sites to aid people in contacting them and in accessing their service but this form of ~~access~~ can be restrictive to rural and isolated people of poor socioeconomic status as a result of distance to travel and poor internet services. While these services ~~can~~ be restrictive to the poor they can be beneficial.

to people in higher socioeconomic groups because of their higher population in the city and easier access to technology.

Discrimination either conscious or unconscious can effect peoples access to socially valued resources through the suppliers of the resources refusing to give help or making assumption that certain people don't need help.
