Many negative impacts could arise if existing inequalities are maintained within the Australian society. These inequalities are seen through the discrimination placed on Indigenous Australians.

Societies can be broadly classified as either egalitarian or stratified. An egalitarian society can be defined as everyone being equal compared to a stratified society which is societies ~~characterised~~ where persons are hierarchically ~~sent~~ categorised into groups such as, class, caste, race, status or gender. Australia prides itself on being an egalitarian society but through maintaining inequalities such as continued discrimination towards ~~the~~ Aboriginals we are shown this is hardly the case. From the time White people have been in Australia

discrimination and prejudice towards Aboriginals has been seen. This is clearly demonstrated when the media ~~has~~ told the Australian society how Australia has breached international human rights laws by cutting welfare payments and imposing bans on pornography and alcohol within Aboriginal communities. This is seen as discrimination as the government, who is holding the power to implement these bans, is only focussing on ~~Aboriginal~~ communities ~~and~~ placing these bans within Aboriginal communities, and not white communities also. This is ~~simple~~ one example of discrimination that has occurred recently which proves the inequalities that still exist within Australia. Although this environment was owned by the Aboriginal persons to begin with, the whites have always believed

Another negative impact ~~could see~~ that could arise if inequalities maintain could see Aboriginals losing their whole way of life due to continued discrimination and prejudice, forcing them to lose their traditional values and cultural heritage. This could result in the loss of Aboriginal culture, which is a horrible and sad implication
