

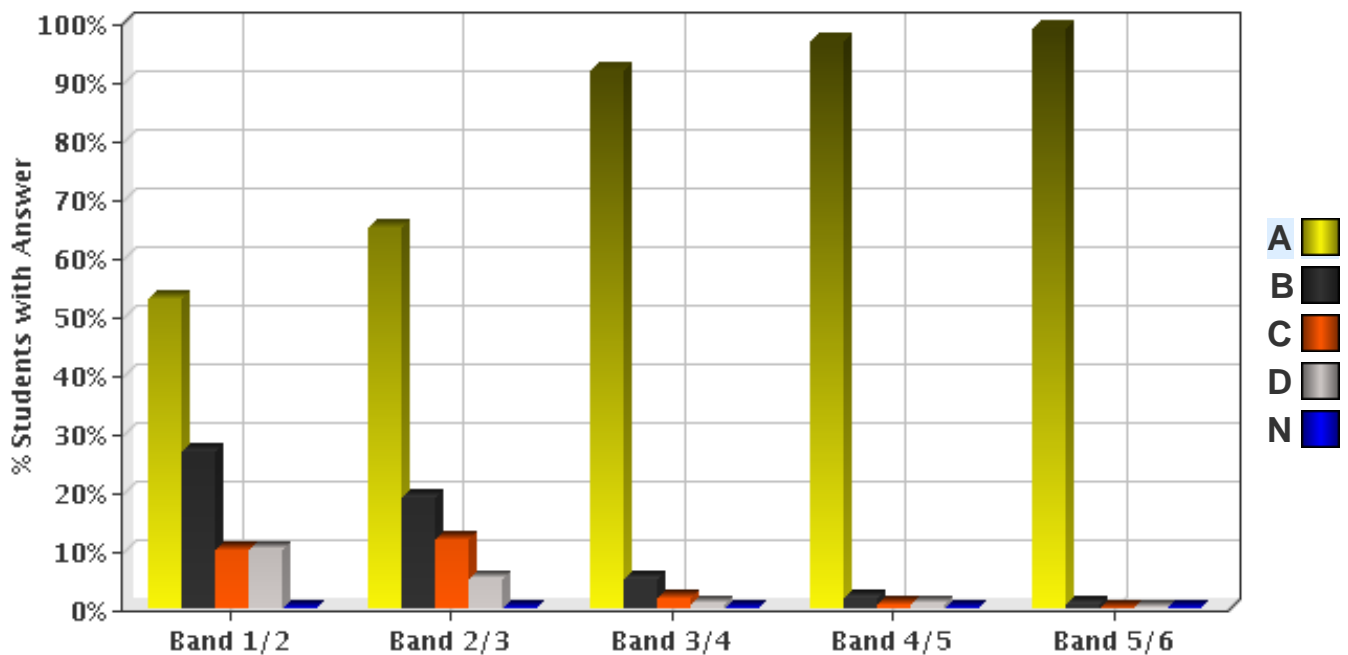
Question 10
