Fur trimmings and the lace up fronts were the fashion with the squared neckline and the ~~bust~~<sup>waist</sup> that sat ~~above~~ underneath the bust. Designers nowadays use the lace up fronts and fur trimmings as well as the waist that sit underneath the bust.

Prue Acton as 70's designer designed gowns and dresses - garmets were the ~~gown~~<sup>waist</sup> that sat under the bust which they were called baby doll dresses



The impact of the design of the medieval period. - house of ~~goat~~ york is ~~the~~ used in the gowns of today. As the lacing at the front are used at the back-like corsets. The lacing in the medieval period later on became the lacing for corsets later in history. Collette ~~Dinnington~~ Dinnington a contemporary designer has ~~go~~ used the lacing in some her designs even being from the back to the front of the garment.

The fur trimmings are mainly scarves but they do ~~not~~ have ~~the~~ fur trimmings on garment around the edge or on the hems of garments. Carry Cooper at the BMW ~~use~~ fashion week one of his designs had the fur trimmings. As his theme was fairy tale creatures.



The neck line is square and low cut. But now the square neck lines are only used on ~~the~~ lingere. Collette Diggimigan ~~uses~~ designs ~~of~~ lingere and uses the square neck line for it's stylish ~~ness~~ ability to place patterns and make the garment wearable but unique.

The long sleeves that draped down to the gown are not ~~in~~ ~~the~~ used. Maybe one day it would be used.

The House ~~of~~ <sup>of</sup> York and the fashion it uses today can be said that "The House of York" is in our wardrobes.
