

When an artwork is being produced, the artist creating it has a reason for producing the work. For some artists such as ~~Y.~~ Mirimura, in ~~his~~ ~~work~~ creating "blinded by the light", the intention and the reaction from the audience differs then from an artist such as Clifford Possum Tjapaltjarri, who created "Honey Ant Dreaming Story".

These artists are completely different in artistic style, but share a strong feel for the reaction from their audiences.

Mirimuras postmodernism photography ~~is~~ portrays a ~~new~~ new image for his audience. He addresses modern ideas

and concepts ~~in his~~ in his artworks through re-inventing past artworks and giving them a whole new meaning

"Blinded by the light" is such a work where Mimamura has re-contextualized an old classical artwork portraying six leppers linking hands while walking down a hillside.

Mimamura's photograph is of a family of five and ~~in the~~ a French artist, who are in the exact positions, but are blinded by money which is covering their eyes.

The meaning of this photograph is a very important one because the artist is addressing today's society



as very consumeristic and is expressing how he feels through his artworks.

Clifford Possum Tjapaltjarri is an artist promoting the goodness ~~in~~ in today's modern society and also the goodness of traditional practises. He believes that modern day society should hold on to ~~any~~ any tradition concepts and practises they may have, as tradition makes people who they are today and what ~~they~~ they are to do in the future.

Artists intentions are very important because without their inspiration for their efforts, their artwork would not nearly be as successful.
