Damien Hurst is a British artist who intends to make people realise that knowone is immortal.

His explicit use of ~~animals~~ dead animals, horrifies yet intrigues audiences as they are bluntly confronted with the topic of death. Some may turn away in horror or disgust yet, it seems that they are turning away in horror at

confrontation of death in General.

Damien Hurst often takes deceased bulls, cows, pigs and other animals, slices them up into sections, and places them ^{each} in a separate container of formaldehyde. When put together the animal is clearly seen as a whole, yet when moved apart, it is clear the animal is in fact not.

Hurst's intentions may seem crazy or horrible, yet it is an issue that seems fit to be addressed, 'People's fear of death'.

Damien Hurst's intentions were extremely important to his artwork, ~~and~~ because if they weren't, his artwork in sure would be seen as an evil practise, crazy, ^{murderous} explicit, and without reason. Although his intentions made it more understandable and more accepted within the world.

Cindy Sherman uses her ~~as~~ photography of women ~~as~~ as an intention to show the degradation and exploitation of women.

Cindy Sherman is a female photographer who creates strong, explicit, confronting and sometimes pornographic images of women.

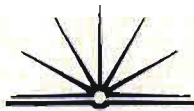

During ^{April} 1937, the small Spanish town of Guernica was attacked and bombed by the Nazi Germans. Pablo Picasso reacted to this in disgust. He could not understand how an innocent town could be attacked and so many innocent die. Upon this horrible attack, Picasso created the somewhat abstract artwork entitled 'Guernica'. His intentions were to show the feelings, emotions and actions of the attack.
