- i) At the meeting with the senators in the temple of Jupiter Stator, Cato held a meeting to discuss what should be done to Catiline, who plots the destruction of the republic. Cato hopes to persuade them to get a senatus consultum ultimum (SCU). ~~Catiline even sends men to kill Cato as ~~secret~~~~.
 - ii). At this particular time of the meeting, Cato tells the senate that Catiline sent 2 men to kill Cato but as he knew of this plan due to secret agent Fulvius, he fortified his walls with a greater number of guards.
 - iii) ad me salutarem refers to the Roman custom of salutatio, where the client greets the patron in the early morning and in return are given a *sportula*.

- iv) Cæsars invites Catiline to go into voluntary exile as he~~s~~ it will ^{benefit} cause the republic and save them from fear.
