Horace gives many signs to his friend in order to be rescued but inappropriately unty he pretends not to understand. The poet Morace uses several techniques to bring out the humorrin this scene such as the effective sight gag of "difforquens oculos," It creates humour as Horace kept on rolling his eyes, nodding, presong and pucking the softest parts of his arms, all for nothing. The use of present participles of "nutains. distriquens, ndens" has the effect of the withness movement, implying Horace's desire to dispatch the box for to langtime. the asynderin, omitting of conjunctions is used to quieken the pace, where Hurace gines his despenale agnals. To Direct speech is used, and being a characteristic of

that makes his satire more effective in langing out his humair one characteristic used in his sakne 3 (not in this extract) is the use of bathor, where a seeming important point is suddenly deflateduis "Tumboi" and "lacetae.
